A meeting of IQAC was inaugurated by Hon'ble Principal, Prof. B.M. Bal on 03.01.2019 at 10.30A.M. in the Conference Hall. Joining as the Resource person of the occasion, Prof. R.P. Das, Hon'ble Vice Chancellor of Berhampur University emphasized on the out of box thinking. In his address, he stressed on the performance of the teachers, which will be judged by the students through feedback system. The teachers should introspect themselves whether they are doing justice to this noble profession or not. He emphasized upon the gender audit, gender discrimination and gender disparity.

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For the enhancement of quality of education, parents, teachers and students should be involved. Alumni meet is an important facet of the system. Community involvement is another important aspect. College must go to community in order to give them a feeling that the educated people have a concern for their well being. No institution functions in isolation, it encounters problems and challenges.

In course of his address, he told that the teachers should not be complacent for getting "A" grade. This is not final and absolute. Success is a continuous process and college should try its level best to maintain this status.

Presently a lot of emphasis is given on quality enhancement and students are the largest beneficiary in the system. More stress should be given on positional power rather than personal power. Quality must be reflected in the behaviour, work and culture, it can be assessed through communication.

In his speech, he harped upon the fact that a teacher should have a rudimentary roll for quality improvement. Quality development is not a overnight phenomenon, it is continuous one. In the concluding address, he threw light on the fact that we all are under a scanner and everybody is assessing us and we should be conscious for that.
