

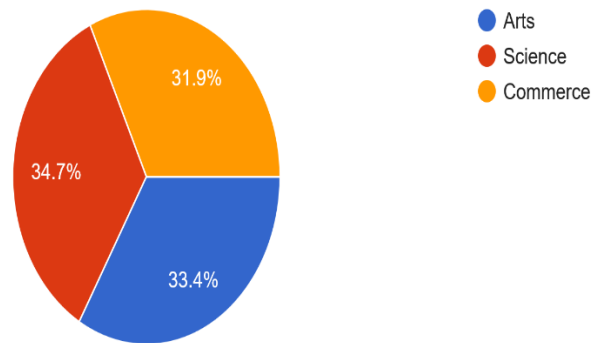
Feedback Analysis on Curriculum and its Transaction

1. Student Participation



Out of the total students given their feedback there are almost equal participation of students from all the streams of Science, Arts and Commerce.

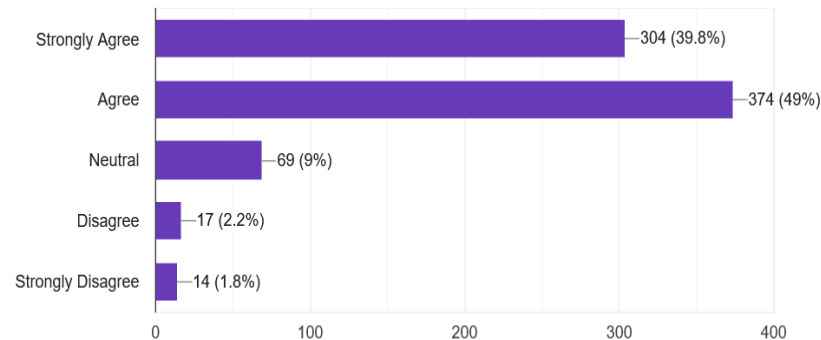

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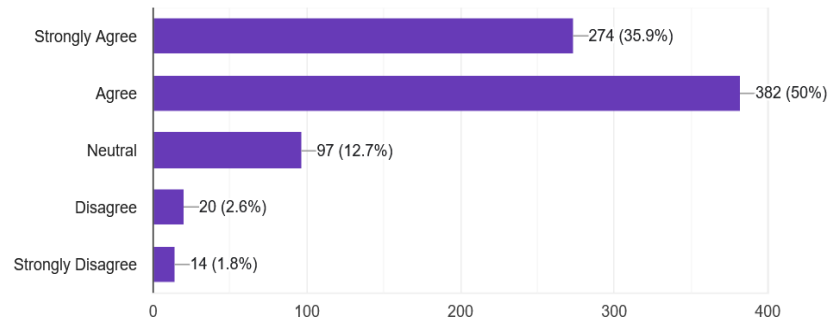

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The teaching methods employed are effective and engaging.



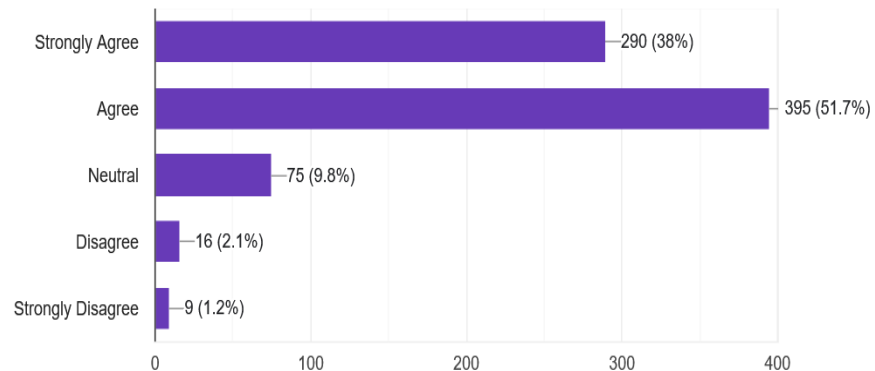

Faculty members adopt a variety of teaching methods such as lectures, discussions, practical, ICT etc. for effective teaching learning



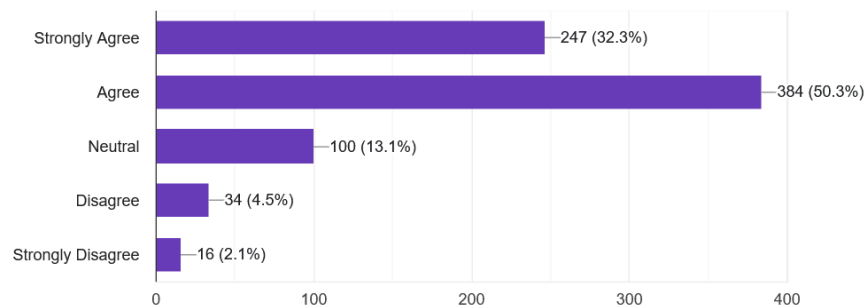

Faculty members are approachable for academic queries and guidance



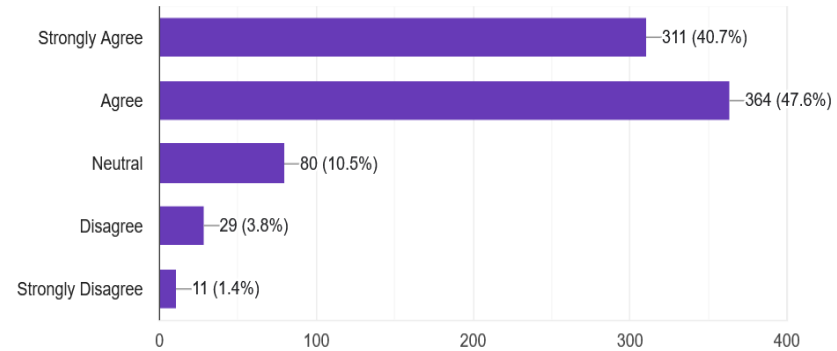

Adequate resources such as libraries, labs, and digital resources are available



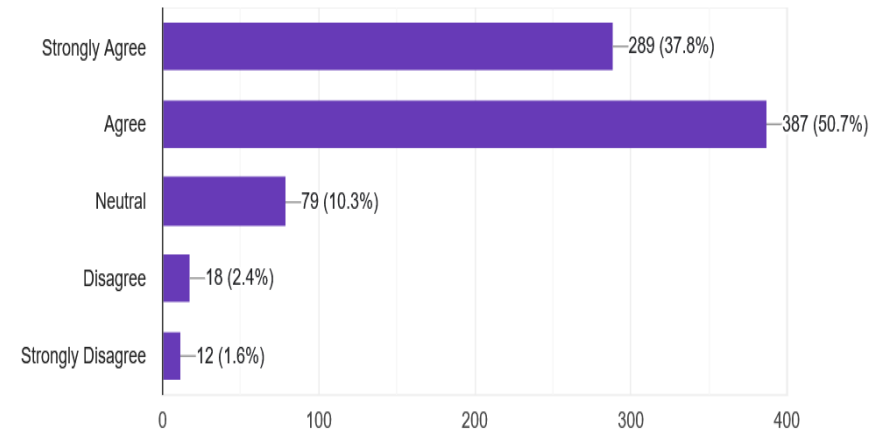

Course materials (textbooks, notes, e contents) are readily available



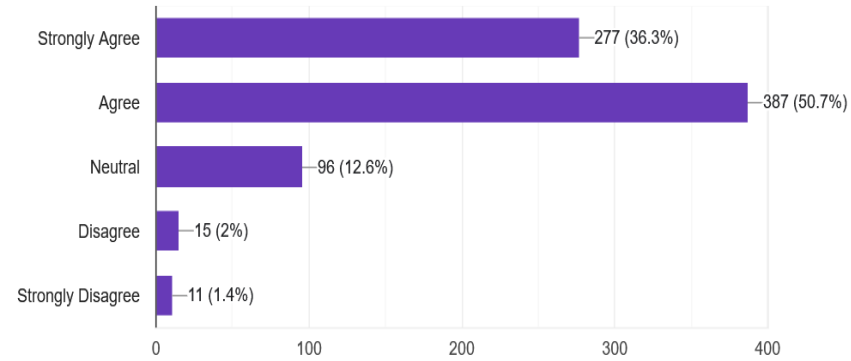
88.3 of the students were pleased with the course materials available in the institution. 10.5% of students remained unconcerned about the availability of resources. At the same time, 5.2% of the students were found dissatisfied with the availability of course materials. The college is looking forward to a spike in study materials for the seamless study of students.

The assessment methods (exams, assignments) are fair and transparent.



88.5 of the students were satisfied with the assessment methods. 10.3% of students remained indifferent to the assessment methods.
